You'll complete a full-time year of professional and academic training to enable you to train Reading Recovery teachers. You'll also provide ongoing professional development and support for trained teachers who work individually with children and co-teach a small group in collaboration with a class teacher.

Excellent communication and organisational skills and the ability to work in a team are essential for being a *Reading Recovery Tutor* and proven leadership qualities advantageous. In addition to professional training and academic study, Tutor training will involve the daily individual teaching of children.
